
- One: God be with you.

# WORDS OF INSTITUTION with the Lord's Prayer

One: We remember that on the night of betrayal and desertion, Jesus gathered the disciples for the feast of Passover, the festival of remembrance. Jesus took bread and the cup, and after giving thanks to you, gave it to the disciples, saying: "Take and eat. Take and drink. Do this in remembrance of me."

- All: Come, Holy Spirit, come. Bless this bread and bless this fruit of the vine. Bless all of us in our eating and drinking at this table, that our eyes may be opened, and we may recognize Christ in our midst, in each other, and in all the world.


