## **COMMITTEE REPORTS**

Our **Deacons** met on Tuesday and discussed the following:

- The Mission Committee recommended that we move \$5,000 into our Angel Fund to assist people from our church or community who are experiencing an unusual crisis. (the purpose of the Angel Fund established by the Deacons in 2013). In addition, \$1,000 will be donated to the United Way of Cortland County for their work in assisting non-profits that deliver services to community members affected by the coronavirus crisis. Both motions passed.
- The Outreach Team reported that they are discussing alternative distribution methods for P.R.E.P. in August. They are completing an application for Nike's "360 Degree" program, hoping for a significant donation of sneakers.
- The Deacons agreed to read and discuss Philip Gulley's *If the Church Were Christian: Rediscovering the Values of Jesus*. Carol Costell Corbin will lead these 10-15 minute discussions at the next several meetings. If you are interested in a copy of the book, call the office. Cost is \$15.
- In light of canceling Holiday in Homer, the Deacons talked about our need to continue efforts in fundraising. Several new ideas were discussed.
