Our **Trustee** held their monthly meeting on Tuesday evening. Items for discussion included:

- Plans for reopening (offered below). Based on the statistics of Covid 19 in Cortland County, we caution that any plan remains fluid. Additionally, when we gather together again, we are each responsible to uphold best practices for our safety.
- Voted to move forward with:
 - The repair of the Jones Hall roof in August. Funding comes from the Capital Project Fund within the Endowment Fund.
 - o Memorial Garden work will be completed by Molly Ulrich.
 - o Repair of the stairs in Jones Hall will be completed soon.
 - o Repairs to the steeple clock will begin in July. Funding for the entire project has been donated as a memorial.
 - Sanctuary audio system updates will be scheduled for this summer. Funding comes, in part, from the Memorial Committee and a gift in memory of Peter Jeffers.

TENTATIVE PLAN FOR REOPENING

NOTE: Should Covid cases rise in our area, this plan will be revised.

As we look forward and as we listen to guidance from NY State, the CDC and the United Church of Christ, the following plan for reopening our building has been accepted by our Deacons and Trustees:

From now through August 2

Online Worship continues, this includes our *God on Film* series.

August 9 – September 6

Church on the Green – under a tent and streamed online.

September 13 - Rally Day

Church in the Sanctuary begins; online streaming continues.

Our plan provides ample time to install necessary upgrades for bathrooms (touchless soap dispensers, etc.) and our sanctuary (audio and visual technology).

Considering the safety of each person, including the most vulnerable among us, we recommend:

- As a vital means of protecting the ones we love, **masks** will be mandatory for everyone ages 2 and up. Disposable masks for children and adults will be available. If you do not want to wear a mask, we invite you to take advantage of our online service until a vaccine is available.
- Whether inside or outside, we will observe **6 feet distancing** between quarantine groups. Please observe seating arrangements as marked.
- While human interaction is important to us, until further notice, there will be no coffee hour following services.

This is our shared policy. As we care for one another, observing these guidelines becomes our collective responsibility. Thank you for helping us to return to our green and then to our building even while we keep one another safe.
